A big **Thankyou** to so many of our parents and carers who responded to the Anti-Racism Strategy Questionnaire. Your feedback has been really important in guiding our next steps forward as a school. We realise that there is still a lot to work on and we have a clear plan going forward with some key short term and long-term goals. We really value your voices and your continued support.

- 97% of families feel welcome and part of our school community
- 82% know what the Hangleton Primary anti-racism strategy means
- 87% know who to ask for help or support
- 91% would feel comfortable about approaching staff about a racial incident or abuse
- 73% feel confident that a racial incident will be dealt with appropriately
- 88% would know what to do if a situation or racial incident made them feel uncomfortable
- 79% feel that the Hangleton curriculum reflects their family's culture and lived experience
- 77% feel that the school communicate effectively regarding the ARE strategy
