Each child has been provided with a KS2 CGP workbook for Maths and Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation. It is expected that two pages from each book are completed every week and returned to their class teacher.

Children are also asked to continue to practice their timetables on TimesTable RockStars weekly.

Reading for pleasure

Each class will have a reading journal scrapbook where children can produce a book recommendation. Your child will come home with this at some point in the year, along with some crafting materials and resources, to share a book they have really enjoyed.

We also ask that you encourage your child to read regularly at home.

SATs revision

Each child will be given SATs revision packs during parents evening. This will cover: maths arithmetic, problem solving and reasoning, spelling and grammar activities. It is suggested that children spend ten minutes a day working through these. Answers will be provided so they can self mark or you can mark together.

Topic Extra Learning Suggestions:

1) Use photographs or statements from family members to show how members of your family are similar in looks or personalities.

2) Research an animal which has adapted to its environment. The more unusual, the better and explain how it has adapted to its surroundings.

3) Make a poster or leaflet about Charles Darwin or Alfred Russell Wallace

Information you could include:

- When and where were they born?
- Where did they work?
- What were their important scientific discoveries?

4) Make a poster or write a story/essay about how the world would be different if dinosaurs had not gone extinct.
