Times tables: emphasis on rapid recall and corresponding division facts.

It's important for children to know all the multiplication facts up to 12×12 and then transfer this knowledge to division facts. This will allow your child to have an instant recall of the facts and free up their memory for more challenging maths tasks. The children will undertake a national test at the end of Year 4 and the expectation is for them to know all tables to 12×12 . The tables we will be learning each week are set out below. Please practise daily at home.

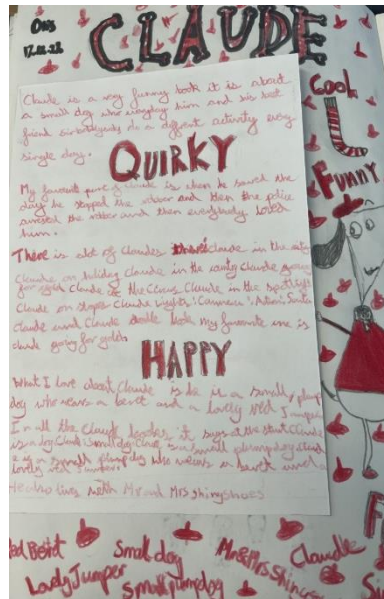
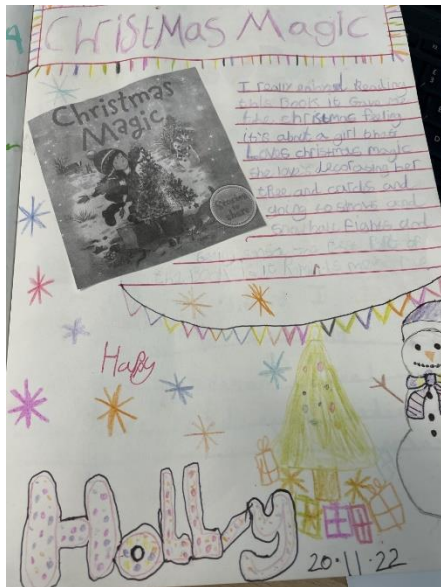
