### Lotions and Potions

### Art

Children will design and make egg sculptures inspired by the artist Peter Carl Faberge. They will also make wands and draw dragon's eyes.

### RE

Children will cover Bar Mitzvah (Judaism), The Bible, The Christian Church and Holy Art.

### English

Initially children will be working on instructions and explanations linked to their own spells. Then for the rest of the half-term, we will use Harry Potter, The Philosopher's Stone, to create descriptive and persuasive writing.

### PSHE

As part of the "I am a Star" topic, children will be focusing on their learning skills (learning behaviours) and working with others. Additionally, we will be emphasising the importance of practising mindfulness daily.

### French

Mr Edwards will be recapping on greetings, classroom instructions, counting to 20, being able to say how old you are and describing your family.

### Music

All children will continue to learn musical skills, linking it to our Lotions and Potions topic.

### Science

Science is our main topic focus this term; learning about different materials and their properties. We will also be conducting practical experiments involving filtration and evaporation.

### Maths

We will be extending the children's knowledge of Place Value and their use of mental and written methods for all four operations. Learning all times tables and division facts up to 12 x 12, is still an on-going focus.

### Computing

Revising e-Safety then using Sketch-up for designing a new Hogwarts School. There will be opportunities for topic-based lessons to be taught, through computing.
