

Maths:

Year 4 will be developing their understanding of Place Value with larger numbers, focussing on how to use practical apparatus and visual representations to support a deeper understanding. We will be learning formal written methods for addition and subtraction. Times tables learning will continue with 3,4,6 and 8 times tables

Science:

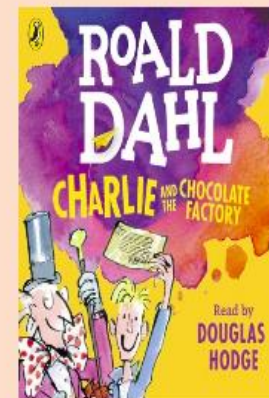
We will learning about Changing States – solids, liquids and gasses through the process of melting, cooling and dissolving. The children will carry out investigations and record their results.

RE:

We will be learning about who Abraham is and the key concepts of Judaism.

English:

We will be reading and using Charlie and the Chocolate Factory to inspire our writing. By reading the rich language in the text, we will be able to use this to write setting and character descriptions, diary entries and then a prequel to the story.



DT:

In DT we will be designing and testing our own chocolate bar. This will include the brand name and the wrapping, making it appealing to the consumer.
