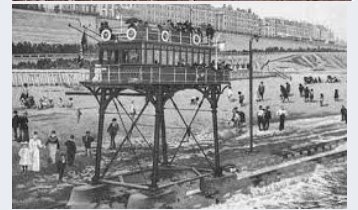
Monarch	The King or Queen in charge of the country
Victorian Era	The time when Queen Victoria ruled (1837 to 1901)
Reign	Another word for Era, or the time that she ruled
British Empire	Queen Victoria was in charge of lots of countries around the world
Industrial Revolution	A time when lots of new inventions happened and new things were built
Invention	Something new that is created
Map	An image showing where things are in the world.
Aerial view	What we see if we look down from above like a bird
Coast	The edge of the country where land meets the sea
Holiday resort	A place that is popular with tourists for their holidays
Seaside	Beach areas on the coast
