A huge palace in the centre of Beijing.



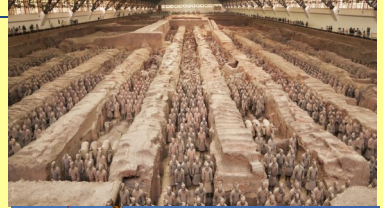
Great Wall of China
