Scotland – Edinburgh

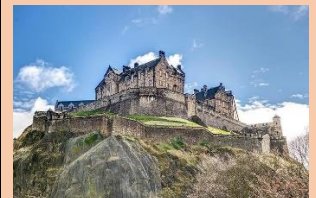
Wales – Cardiff
