Cacao Bean - a dried, fermented, fatty seed of the fruit of a South American tropical evergreen tree,

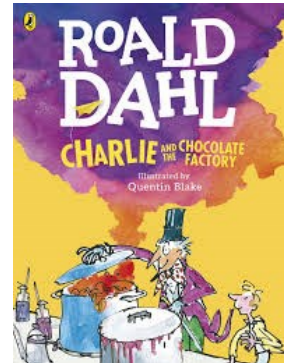
Brands- a type of product manufactured by a particular company under a particular name.

Ingredients - any of the foods or substances that are combined to make a particular product.

Plantations - an estate on which crops such as coffee, sugar, and cocoa beans are grown.

Tropical Regions - the regions of Earth surrounding the Equator.

Harvested- the grain or fodder from crops
