Information Book- We will be creating a non-fiction book all about castles.

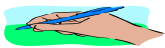

***Art**- Exploring portraits and creating a self-portrait as a medieval King or Queen.

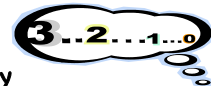
***History**- Looking and comparing what life was like in a castle compared to now. Comparing Elizabeth 1 with Elizabeth 2.
